Meeting called to order and Mr. Newton welcomed everyone. This electronic meeting is being recorded as well as minutes taken.

Approval of Minutes:

Ms. Davidson made a motion to approve the minutes of May 21, 2020. Mr. Trayer seconded the motion. **Approval was unanimous.**


FY '20 Budget Amendment:

Ms. Colvin is working on a budget amendment. Pharmacy and Anthem costs are fluctuating. At this time maintenance and medical costs are both being estimated. Bed rental funds that were not used are being used to cover some of the expenditures. The difference after redistribution of funds is \$241,050.00. Mr. Trayer made a motion to present the budget amendment to the Board on June 23, 2020. Ms. Davidson seconded the motion. **Decision was unanimous.** The amendment will also need to be approved at the June 23, 2020 meeting.

Covid 19 Update:

Mr. Newton presented an update on MRRJ actions in response to Covid 19. At this time there are no substantive changes. There are several expenditures which are being tracked. The jail has applied for both FEMA and VDEM grants. When approved will submit expenditures for reimbursement.

Ms. Whetzel discussed CARE Act funding. This may be an option to cover some of the costs incurred.
